

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The Best For Riding

Brooks Saddles have long been marketed under the slogan 'The Best For Riding', and since the 1880's we have been producing an annual catalog of our cycle saddles and luggage to honour this commitment. The edition you hold in your hands marks an important company anniversary, for in 2016 we celebrate an unbroken tradition of manufacturing in the heart of the West Midlands dating back no less than 150 years.

It is by now widely known that in 1866 the eponymous J.B. Brooks established a business under the family name in Great Charles Street, Birmingham. As the famous story goes, the company had been producing equestrian tack and harness plus sundry leather goods for over a decade, when the demise of J.B. Brooks' own faithful horse led to his trying out the very latest mode of transportation, the bicycle. Delighted at the freedom offered by this new machine, he was nonetheless disappointed by its unforgiving wooden seat.

Determined to banish posterior aches and pains, and grow his business in the process, the industrious Mr Brooks invented the precursor of a great many innovative designs for leather bicycle saddles, filing his first patent in the year 1882. Hundreds more patents were registered over the ensuing decades, covering all manner of items dedicated to improvements in equipment and accoutrements required by the cyclist. Not only saddles, but products ranging from all-weather protective outerwear such as capes, galoshes, ponchos and sou'westers, to an enormous variety of sturdy and stylish luggage for bicycles, autos and motorcycles. Amongst hundreds of designs were included special bags, cases and holsters for the transportation of cameras, golf clubs, swords and rifles, even cigars and newspapers!

As the diverse range of high quality goods bearing the Brooks Brand continued to expand, the company name became synonymous with comfort, durability and innovation. Exported to the farthest corners of the globe, by the 1950s Brooks had become the world's

largest bicycle saddle manufacturer. Today, Brooks still maintains an enviable and unrivaled reputation for excellence, still producing innovative, relevant and practical products for cyclists the world over.

Never stinting or compromising, but continuing to promote design and innovation, and all the while using nothing but the finest materials, Brooks has become the quality benchmark against which other saddles, cycling luggage and sundry goods are measured. We continue to create superlative goods at our historic Smethwick facility, and most recently in Italy as well. Moving confidently into the future in the spirit of our illustrious forebears, we aspire to a further century and a half devoted to indispensable and quite incomparable products for bicyclists and other connoisseurs of stylish quality goods.

Proud though we most undoubtedly are of the previous one hundred and fifty years of company heritage, we don't plan to rest on our laurels. We believe that to maintain our position of preeminence, we must continue to embrace change while respecting our tradition. And just as the popularity of cycling itself shows no signs of decline, the enthusiasm with which our endeavours are received by the public grows from one season to the next.

As such, in the past years we have further expanded our range of cycle luggage with many exciting and contemporary designs, we still use the same superior leather with which we have always made our saddles while exploring the latest materials and manufacturing techniques. These new designs aspire to be just as innovative as our saddles, as we seek to provide solutions to the myriad challenges confronting the carrier today.

As we reach the halfway point of our second century, we find our operations have expanded beyond our traditional manufacturing base in the United Kingdom. Our customers may now benefit from the artisanal skills of craftspeople in Italy, a nation with a long tradition of fine, handmade goods. This year, a new line of elegantly understated handmade Italian small leather accessories now supplements our range of stylish and eminently practical all-weather cycling garments and protective headwear marketed under the name John Boultbee.

Brooks has always benefitted from the critical feedback of those who use our products, and we have never shied from publishing criticism as well as praise. The experience of the many who choose Brooks informs our work as we expand and improve our product offering, forging ahead into the latter half of our second century teeming with new ideas for cycling.



Early Champions

In the early days of the twentieth century, bicycle racing was regarded as a working man's sport. Much more than merely a means to get to and from work, the bicycle enabled the common man to transcend the hard life of the factory, offering the chance to become a hero by virtue of his sporting dedication. Quite literally, thousands of riders made their living as salaried wheelmen in the inter-war period now thought of as the 'golden age' of cycle sport. As bicycle racing became increasingly professional, Brooks Saddles soon became the choice de rigeur of the pro peloton, saddles from other brands the exception to the rule.

The staples of our cycle saddle offerings remain the classic models comprising our Leather Saddle Lines. More than a century of designing unparalleled bicycle saddles topped with pliant yet highly durable leather has seen our range expand to a great number of varying designs, and now comprise six lines. We have recently introduced the innovative line of Cambium Saddles using vulcanised natural rubber and organic cotton canvas. To ease the task of selecting the right saddle, we have grouped them into those for Road & Off use, for Touring & Trekking and for City & Heavy Duty riding.

Whatever the product category, Brooks is committed to producing designs utilizing natural materials and construction techniques whenever possible, keeping alive the proud and timeless traditions which make Brooks Products sought after by discerning cyclists to this day.

A Poor Saddle is Bad Economy

Where the would-be owner of the new bicycle seeks maximum value for their investment, the reputable vendor counters with a sincere desire to back up any recommendations with sound knowledge. Here he or she draws upon long experience of cycling as both pastime and sport, as well as a trade. After all, any retailer of standing knows that the happy customer is the one most likely to return with further business.

Having decided thus far upon pretty much the best of everything, we strongly advise you not to adopt a miserly attitude in choosing this most important interface between you and your new machine, the saddle from upon which you'll be pushing the pedals.

Some cyclists labour under the false perception that opting for a cheaper saddle is a worthwhile saving. In the professional experience, more often than not, these individuals spend considerably more in replacement items over the long term. In many instances they end up using their bicycle far less often if indeed at all, owing to the sheer discomfort they must endure upon an unsuitable and poorly manufactured saddle.

Finest Quality Leather

The 5-year-old Brooks Saddle on the bike has since some time reached the point where it can be considered to be perfectly "broken in", the rider rewarded with a state of optimum comfort. Leather is a most peculiar material, and the old company adage that "There is nothing like leather for Saddles" holds as true today as it ever did.

In our enviable position as market leaders, Brooks are able to select only the very finest hides. As was always the case, only top grade vegetable-tanned leather is used in the manufacture of Brooks Saddles. These 'Butts', as the thicker hind end of a leather hide is known, are rigorously inspected for unavoidable natural flaws, which whilst not detracting from the

quality of the leather as a whole, must nonetheless be avoided when cutting Brooks Saddle tops.

These material remainders are not wasted, as they are used in the manufacture of other sundry products in the Brooks Range, such as our Mud Flaps and Plump Grips.

We want to ensure your future custom, so that by looking after you we do the same for ourselves and in the surest way possible. Moreover, having cycled many a mile and for a good many years, you can take comfort in our recommendations being founded upon real experience.

The Benefits of Rubber

You might have been surprised to learn that Brooks recently introduced a new range of saddles featuring rubber and cotton canvas uppers. In actual fact however, Brooks first began to experiment with rubber as an alternative to leather as far back as 1928, and even released a number of rubber models to combat

leather shortages in Britain during the Second World War. Afterwards, progress in this area came to a halt, but contemporary advancements have made it possible again to confidently offer a viable alternative to our traditional leather saddle designs.

Rubber is a natural product, harvested in liquid form from the bark of the Pará tree. It is a most versatile material, used in myriad applications, and highly prized by product designers for its many virtues, principal amongst them being its great elasticity, and resistance to water. Resilience to degradation is achieved by blending the natural rubber with a percentage of synthetic rubber. Recent developments in manufacturing techniques have placed rubber firmly back on the list of materials well suitaed to enhancing rider comfort in ways no other material can match.



Another Road

Cycling has always been a pastime subject to limitless interpretation by its practitioners, and now adventuresome riding upon unpaved gravel roads is once again enjoying an upsurge in popularity. Though many wonderful advances have been made of late in cycle technology, the unpaved roads themselves remain unchanged, and unforgiving as ever. Comfort and durability were highly prized by the wheelmen of yore, just as they are enjoyed by todays devotees of Brooks. Today just as much as then, the challenge of a rough surface is best met from astride a comfortable perch.

The Cambium

The saddles comprising the Cambium range feature a durable, waterproof and maintenance-free upper made from a strong, yet supple, vulcanised natural rubber, to which a layer of organic cotton canvas is bonded. This revolutionary, uniquely flexible top is suspended upon a lightweight frame, functioning much like a hammock to comply with the motion of the rider and absorb shocks and vibrations. It is this unique performance characteristic that sets Cambium Saddles apart from the competition.

Whether the jarring cobbles of the pavé, the uncertain conditions of an autumn cyclocross race, the intensity of a criterium, or the exhaustion of an ultramarathon event, the Cambium guarantees to keep the rider not only comfortable, but connected to his or her machine like no other saddle on the market.

The vulcanised rubber top is not only waterproof, but built in such a way as to be practically indestructible. They are thereby perfect for the cyclist who desires the most practical and reliable saddle upon which to enjoy the journey of a lifetime, or a lifetime of journeys.

Moreover, Cambium Saddles are assembled from replaceable parts whose maintenance does not require any special tools. Should a Cambium saddle be subject to damage due to accident, spare parts can be readily obtained and repairs carried out with ease, either by the owner themselves or ideally by a Brooks Dealer of Excellence.

The C17, with which we introduced this newest generation of saddles, achieves a racy and pared-down aesthetic, but is equally suitable for touring cyclists and commuters, as well as for racing cyclists. In fact its sporty appearance is the direct result of the design having been closely modeled upon the geometry and dimensions of that timeless best-seller, the B17. It therefore offers the same unsurpassed comfort for mile after mile.

The C17 S is the sister of the men's C17, slightly shorter in length overall and thereby more suitable

for ladies anatomy. Apart from the subtle ergonomic changes, it does not differ as regards materials and construction. The svelte profile and tried and tested geometry were devised from those of its leather precursor, the classic B17 S.

The Carved models benefit from a specially shaped aperture, derived from the registered cutting initially developed for our Imperial Saddle models. This cut-out substantially reduces the perineal pressure which can inconvenience riders covering longer distances. The enhanced flexibility of the saddle upper is comparable to the function of a shock absorbing seat post, but without any change in the riders position, nor mechanical complications.

A recent addition along similar comfort lines to the C17 Carved is the C19, a broader version designed with a more upright cyclist in mind. Suitable for relaxed touring, utility bicycles, or any time the cyclist is seated in a position with a spine angle of 60° to 90°.

The svelte C15 was the first Cambium model intended specifically for use by racing cyclists. Narrow

for pedaling freedom and further weight reduction, the C15 redefines priorities, aiding performance by placing comfort at the fore.

The very latest addition to the expanding Cambium range is the incredibly lightweight C13, which barely moves the scales, weighing in at only 259 grammes. Beneath the black organic cotton canvas upper, and the 'hammock' of vulcanised rubber, our designers have fashioned a monocoque base from carbon fibre rather than the aluminium and steel used for its siblings. The good looks of the C13 are further enhanced by the rivet heads and saddle rails, which are also finished in black.

We know our Cambium Saddles are among the best saddles we have ever made, because we receive so much positive feedback from Cambium adoptees. Firm but remarkably supple, they help maximize the potential of every cyclist whose aim is speed, taking discomfort out of the equation and allowing the rider to concentrate solely on success.

Styles of Riding

Brooks make saddles to cater to nearly every kind of cycling. For dedicated racers or athletic riders who ride leaning far forward with their weight on the handlebars, both on Road & Off, Brooks has many offerings, among them the highly elastic B15 Swallow, the somewhat stiffer Swift, or the highly stiff and durable Team Professional. These models also available in "S" versions for ladies, and Titanium models for maximum weight reduction.

Those riders who cycle both the regular route to work, or on longer tours reaching as far as a lifetime, we have a range of saddles whose main feature is a wider top than those of the sports range, also providing both comfort and longevity. The classic and perennial favourite of this range is the B17, which has been providing Touring and Trekking cyclists with great comfort since the 1890s. The saddles from this range accommodate a more



upright riding position, while still allowing for occasional uptempo riding. Alternatively, the Flyer, with its additional coil springs, has been providing enhanced comfort to touring cyclists since 1927.

Much further afield from the racing line is our range of City and Heavy Duty saddles, such as the B73, made with twin rails and no fewer than three springs to ease the toil of perhaps a goods bike-pushing delivery lad. These saddles are made for a thoroughly upright riding position, and are likewise outfitted with coil springs to soak up the

"Actually the differences can be quite subtle at first glance, yet over time the need for such variation will become more obvious. For example,

the Select line, made from the very toughest of hides is intended for high-mileage cyclists. The extra resilience of the specially selected organic leather cannot easily be judged by the eye.

"The decagonal icon used for all Special Saddles denotes the use only of copper rivets, the soft metal being more gentle on the leather upper, thus increasing saddle longevity. Each broadheaded rivet has been precisely hammered by hand, to prevent any damage to the hide upper.

"The Unique logo is reserved solely for those saddles which are distinguishable by some aspect of workmanship or time honoured design detail specific to only that particular model. Some of these unique designs have in fact been in production for a great many years, a testament to the ingenuity of Brooks designers past.

"The Classic line comprises many of Brooks best selling saddles for today's bike rider. All of which have single supporting rails and can therefore be attached to modern micro-adjustable seat posts. Case in point, the B17, the most popular Classic design, which has in fact been in continuous production since 1896!"

"This Imperial logo looks a little like the pump badge for a hand drawn cask ale!?"

"In fact the Imperial symbol does indicate another old tradition, being reserved for saddles featuring Brooks' most ingenious cut-out to reduce perineal pressure."

"Cutting out numbness then."

"Quite. Lastly, though by no means least, the Aged line of saddles, benefitting from a most pronounced suppleness and dispensing with the need to 'break-in' the saddle. Aged models are often described by satisfied purchasers as being 'Comfortable from Day One'.



Everything Must Change

By the late 1800's Brooks Saddles especially designed for women further helped boost the popularity of the bicycle amongst ladies of the era. Up until the post-war period, the costs of motor car ownership remained prohibitively expensive for many women. In great numbers they therefore turned to the bicycle for their mobility, and it became a symbol of increasing women's liberation. The simple joy of setting forth on a bicycle was compounded with the newfound ease though which the ladies could now free themselves from the increasingly irksome but avoidable demands of their menfolk.

Proper Adjustment

Your new bicycle has been assembled and set-up for perfect function. Before you can wheel it out of the store however, the vendor has a few more wise words to impart.

"Not so hastily sir, if you please. It's essential that we now tailor the height and position of your saddle before you set off. After all, your cycling should always be a pleasure, and never a toil."

"I'm all for cutting out the toil, that's for sure! So, is there some rule of fitment to be adhered to?"

"Not a hard and fast rule, but there are some guiding principles to observe. The weight of your body should be borne by the broad rear portion of the saddle, the slimmer peak being there to keep your lower half steady and balanced.

"I've already set the seat post to a level suggested by your height. With the bike quite upright and steadied, climb aboard. Now, place your heel on the lower pedal at the 6-o'clock position. If the saddle is at the proper height, your leg should not be completely extended, there should still be a slight bend at the knee but without even a suspicion of a stretch to reach the pedal."

"Feels just right!" exclaims the new owner.

"Looks right to me too," replies the vendor, also smiling. "You'll note your saddle is affixed just far enough behind the centre line of the crank axle that you find yourself sitting naturally on the broad section of the saddle. When you pedal, you won't be pulled forwards by the thrust of each leg.

I've set the peak of the saddle just high enough to ensure that you won't slip, either forwards or backwards. The saddle should always be set more or less flat.

Time to go for a trial spin hereabouts, though I'd ask you to return shortly and give me your opinion. Try it out, then come straight back, as I've a few further words of advice regarding care and maintenance of the bike and in particular of the saddle we've just fitted."

Maintenance & Care

The B66 & B67

Some further time having elapsed, the happy cyclist is once more in the bike store, and beaming with pleasure after a brief inaugural ride. The vendor has explained about the need to bring back the bike after some hundred-odd miles for a further check-up. General care and maintenance of the bike have been discussed, but before the purchaser may finally depart, the seller has more to say.


"This saddle will provide you with years of lasting comfort, but for maximum durability, I'd advise you to follow a simple care routine.

"If you're not solely a fair weather cyclist, try not to leave the bike out in the wet if that can be avoided at all. Corrosion of other parts aside, the leather saddle upper will begin to deteriorate if subject to repeated soakings.

"If the top slackens noticeably, careful tightening of the tensioning bolt located under the saddle nose is necessary. Tighten it only by small increments, no more than 90° at a time. Please remember that should the

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limit of the thread be reached, no further tensioning will be possible. Avoid over-tensioning the saddle, importantly, never tension the saddle if it is wet, nor apply saddle conditioner unless the leather is quite dry. Don't be tempted to dry your saddle by artificial means."

The vendor then hands the cyclist a small tin of Brooks Proofide Leather Dressing.

"This contains a specially formulated combination of ingredients with which to 'dress' the leather top. The sparing but thorough application of Proofide will assist the process of 'breaking-in' your saddle, keeping it supple and shower-proofing the leather. Apply a small amount to the finished uppermost side of the leather, allowing it to permeate until dry before polishing off with a soft cloth. Also use Proofide for the underside of the saddle, and in this case do not polish away after application. Repeat this process several times during the initial 'breaking-in period', and every few months thereafter, and your saddle will reward you with comfort for mile after mile and many years to come."

These items were manufactured from the finest woven Egyptian cotton, with invulnerable seams stitched to withstand the worst that English weather had to offer.

Since this time, the clothing and textile industries have changed much in their approach to technical outerwear. The overwhelming trend has been to move away from traditional designs and fabrics. Nowadays, the honest virtues of natural materials and classic garments are too often neglected in favour of the dubious benefits of newer textiles and utilitarian designs.

Alternatively, you can send a repair query directly to Brooks, so that we can best advise you on how to fix your product. Brooks Saddles are guaranteed against defects in materials or workmanship for 2 years from the date of purchase. If you believe you have a claim under this guarantee, you should return the saddle to the place of purchase along with your proof of purchase.

To safeguard against the loss of your proof of purchase, you may also register your saddle at www. brooksengland.com/forever. This will allow us and your bicycle dealer to prove when your saddle was purchased. You will also be enrolled to receive the Brooks Despatch, our newsletter, to be kept informed of new products, events and other important information.

A 10-year extended warranty will be awarded after you have registered, so do so without delay!

In order to register, you will need to know the production lot of your saddle. It is a 3-digit code stamped underneath your saddle top. This code is a sequence of "number, letter, number". Brooks England will not accept warranty claims due to crashes, accidents, or improper installation or usage.
